Key DPS Drivers

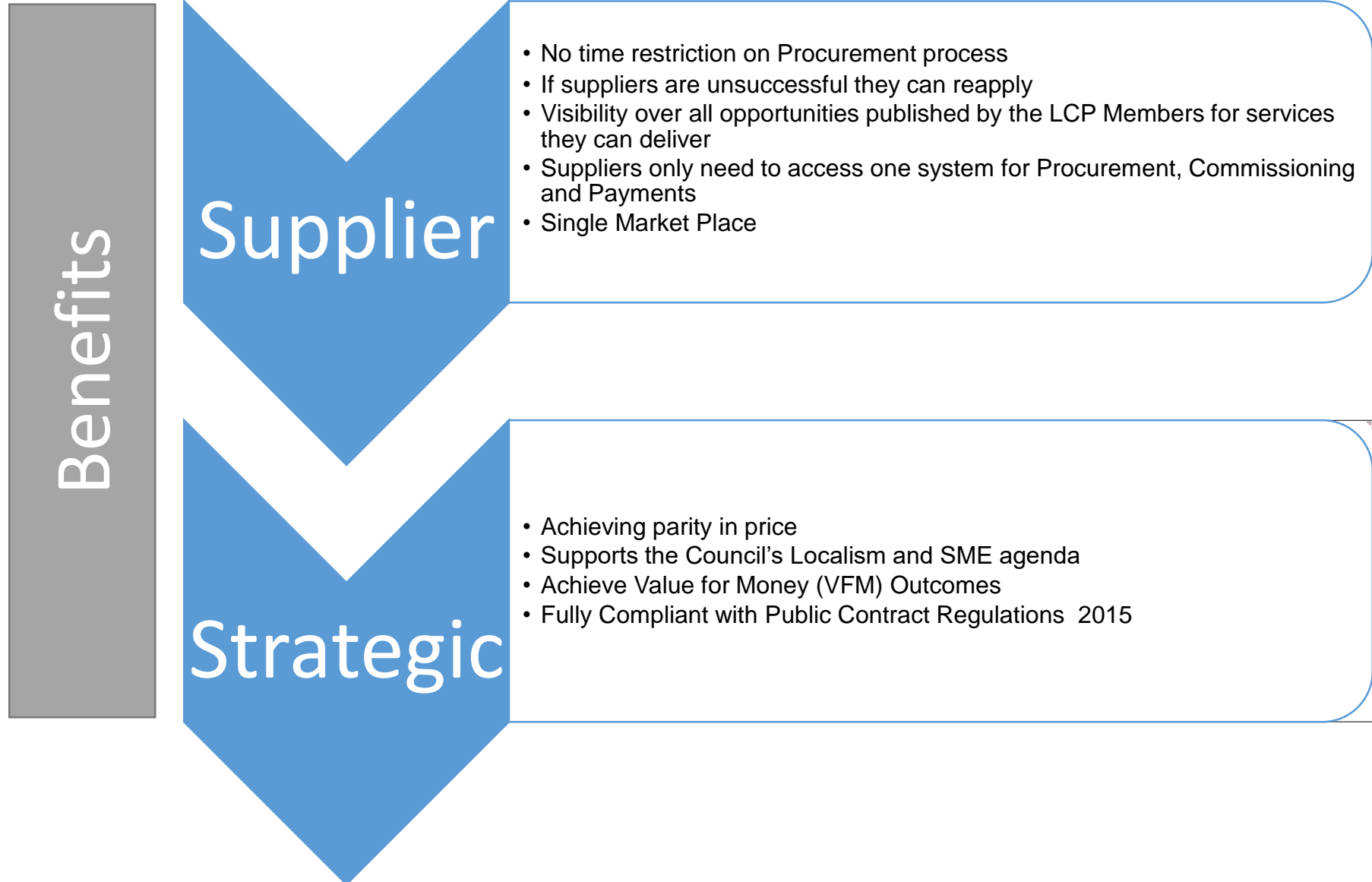
- DPS – end to end electronic platform

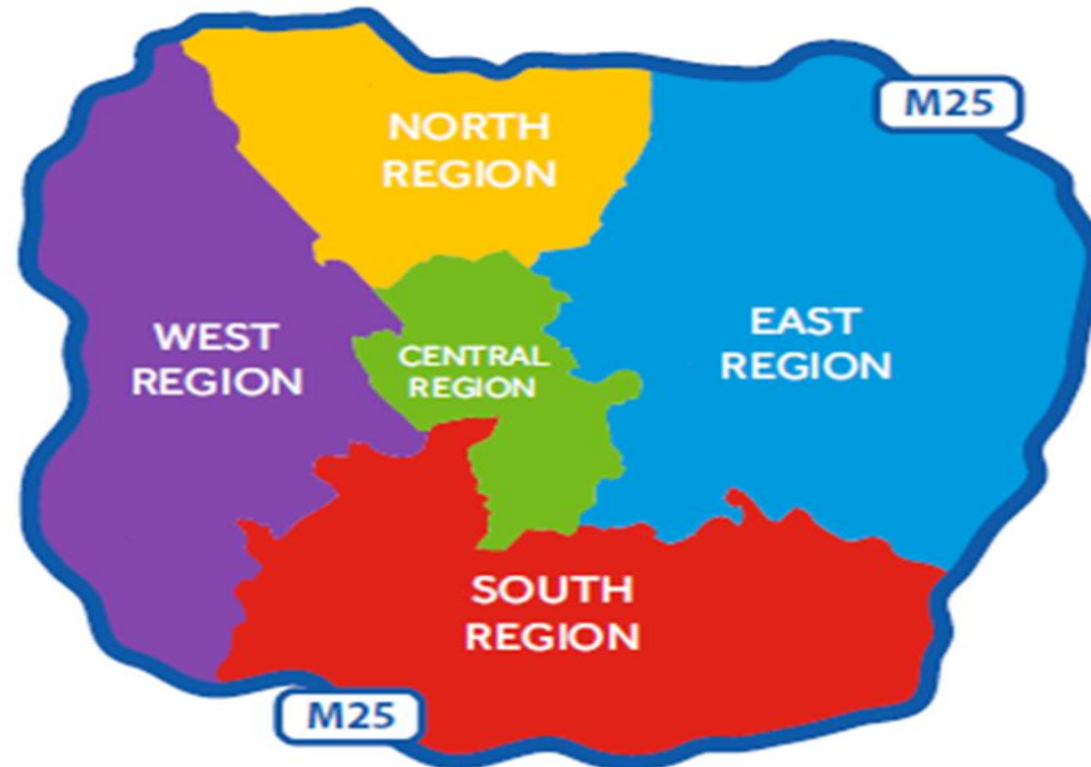

Terminology

- **SProc.Net** – the system used to manage the DPS
- **adam** – the company that owns the SProc.Net system
- **Accreditation & Enrolment (A&E)** – Selection criteria required to be approved on the DPS.
- **Supplier Agreement** – Overarching Terms & Conditions
- **Requirement** – A project/piece of work that needs to be delivered
- **Offer** – A tender response
- **Service Agreement** – A contract to deliver the project/piece of work
- **Service Receipt** – The receipt/invoice for the delivery of the project/piece of work
- **Self-Bill** – System generated invoice
