Our current tender situation...

- We currently use a Framework contract for ALL of our tendering:
- Mainstream transport
- SEN transport
- Children and adult's social services transport
- Both for ad hoc and main tender rounds

Why change?

Disadvantages of using a Framework:

- Closed to new operators restricts the marketplace
- Limits the number of resources available to the Authority

What we have learnt:

- Framework restricts the marketplace
- ✓ DPS opens the marketplace (not closed like a Framework contract)
- **★**DPS did not allow for short notice demand (e-quotes)
- ✓ Framework is flexible and demand responsive

What this means for you......

- A much simpler way to be involved using a new flexible system called Sproc.Net will be in operation, which is transparent, intuitive and flexible
- New operators will be able to apply for the DPS at any point
- The application questions will be kept as easy to answer as possible, with simple yes/no answers
- There will be a helpdesk to deal with any technical problems and Q & A page available

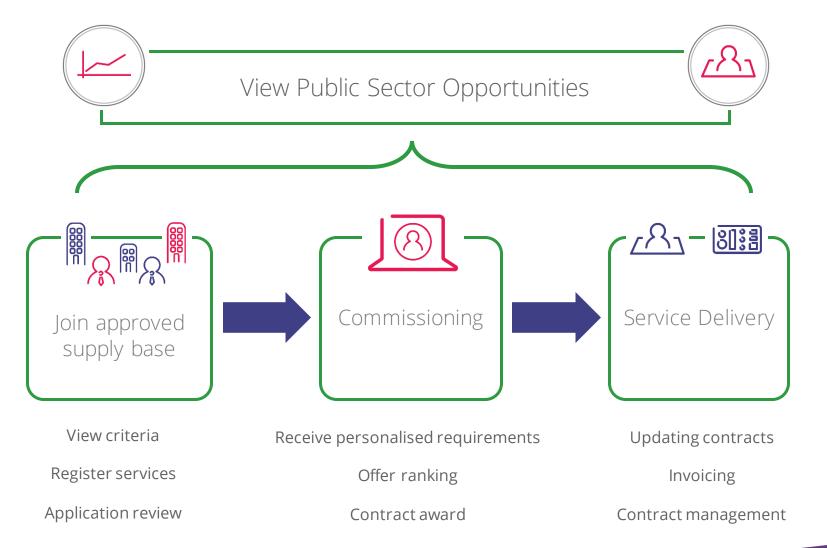






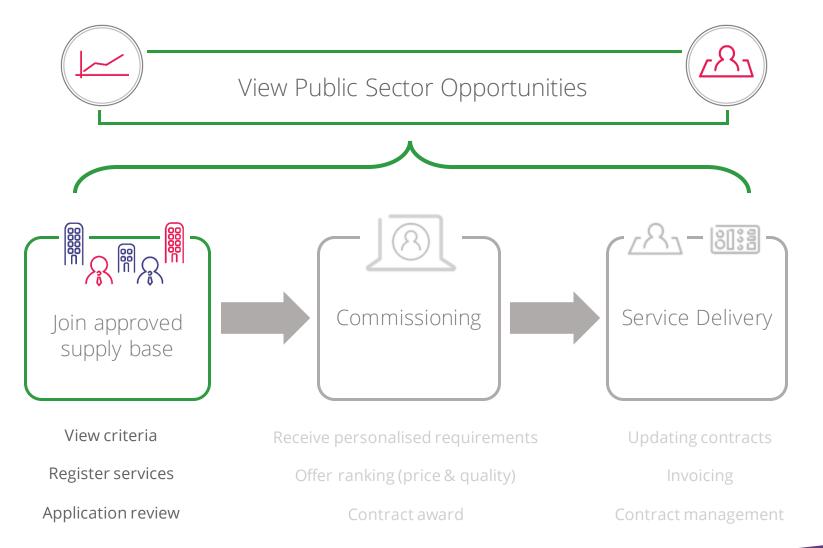

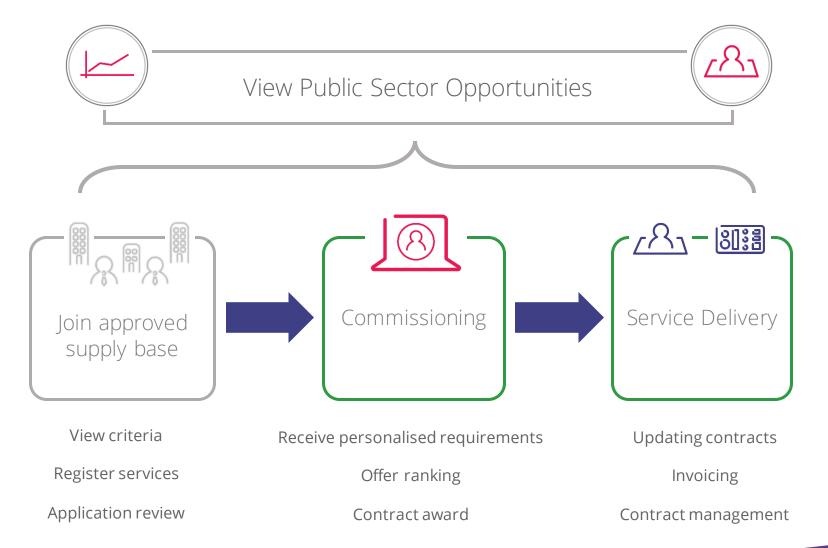
